

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
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
The NLRB Election Statistics Mid-Year 2022 Report covers NLRB election data through June 30, 2022.

NLRB Election Statistics Mid-Year 2022 Report Highlights

There were 372 more NLRB representation elections held during the first six months of 2022 than in the first half of 2021, according to preliminary data analyzed by Bloomberg Law. Unions won 76.6 percent of 837 representation elections held during the first six months of 2022, up from 76.1 percent of 465 elections held during the same period in 2021.




The number of workers eligible to vote in representation elections increased to 54,260 in the first six months of 2022 from 25,222 during the same period in 2021. The number of workers organized by unions increased to 43,150 in first-half 2022 from 18,912 in first-half 2021.

There were 74 decertification elections in the first six months of 2022, up from 70 during the same period in 2021. Unions prevailed in 26, or 35.1 percent, of first-half 2022 decertification elections, compared with 22, or 31.4 percent, in first-half 2021.



AFL-CIO unions won 74.5 percent of their representation elections in first-half 2022 and 74.9 percent in first-half 2021. Unions in the Change to Win federation won 75.9 percent of their representation elections in first-half 2022, up from 67.8 percent in first-half 2021.

The Service Employees (SEIU) led all unions with 293 representation elections through June of 2022 winning 238, or 81.2 percent. The Teamsters held 102 elections, winning 62, or 60.8 percent. The SEIU organized 11,313 workers, and Teamsters organized 2,075 workers, in the first six months of 2022.


A breakdown of first-half 2022 representation elections by bargaining unit size shows that the smallest units held 81 percent of all elections. Unions won 77.3 percent of 678 elections held among bargaining units with fewer than 50 workers and 75.4 percent of those involving units of 50-99 workers. For bargaining units of 100-499 workers and 500 workers or more, unions won 70.5 percent and 83.3 percent, respectively, of representation elections in the first half of 2022.


Of the representation elections held in first-half 2022, 192 took place in states that have right-to-work laws in place. Unions won 75 percent of these elections. In non-RTW states, unions won 77.3 percent of 639 representation elections.

The number of representation petitions filed in the first six months of 2022 rose above 1,000 for the first time since first-half 2016. There were 1,199 representation petitions filed in first-half 2022 compared with 668 representation petitions filed in first-half 2021.

Notes About the Data

Bloomberg Law maintains a database of union elections based on information from the NLRB and its regional offices. Statistics are calculated on a calendar-year basis. Data are available from January 1, 1985.

Bloomberg Law collects election tallies and certifications from the 26 regional offices of the National Labor Relations Board. This data is merged with certified election results reported by the NLRB national office in its monthly "Cases Closed" report.

Bloomberg Law statistics are based on NLRB elections where an outcome has been declared at the regional level, based on a tally of ballots, or at the national level, through the certification of election results. The number of resolved NLRB elections can change over time due to a variety of reasons, including the resolution of challenges and objections, the cancellation of elections, and rerun elections. All historical statistics presented in this report have been revised from previous reports.
